Rarely so many Solemnities are celebrated in one month. The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ reminds us to have the centrality of the Eucharist in our lives. FIRST READING – Deuteronomy 8: 2-3, 14-16

A reading from the Book of Deuteronomy

Moses said to the people: 'Remember how the Lord your God led you for forty years in the wilderness, to humble you, to test you and know your inmost heart - whether you would keep his commandments or not.
