The Parish Office is reviewing the ongoing printing cost that is incurred every Quarter.

At present the cost of printing four pages of the Bulletin (23,000 pages averaged for the quarter) in colour costs \$1,570.00. The cost of printing the same number of papers in Black and White would cost \$156.00.

This is a significant saving of funds. This would mean that the weekly Bulletin would be in Black and White from **September**. As and when needed, we will print in colour. I am eager to get your feedback on this matter. Please use the suggestion box in the foyer.
