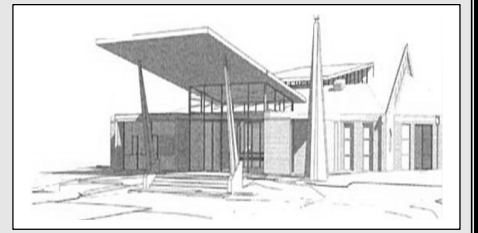

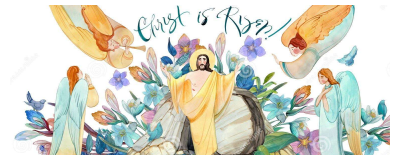
### Mass Intentions:
